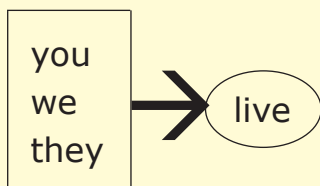
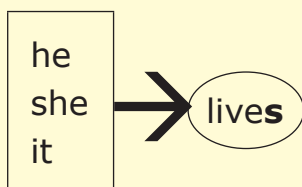
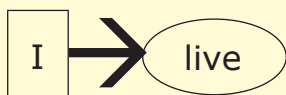
Present simple – uso
