1 Lucy's got an interview today. It's for a new job at her company – Personal Assistant to the new Director for Europe.

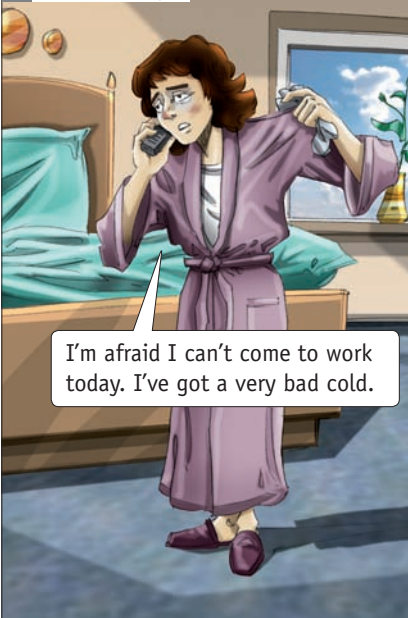


- Chairman** So, Miss Patterson. Please tell us something about your education.
